Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1934: LNER Grand “See The Scenery” Excursion Aberdeen to Aberdeen via Strathspey, Kingussie, Perth (Circular). \*

Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> September 1935: Half-day Excursion Inverurie – Aberdeen (Aberdeen v Dundee).

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November 1935: Half-day Excursion Inverurie – Aberdeen (Aberdeen v Hearts).

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> March 1936: Half-day Excursion Inverurie – Aberdeen (Aberdeen v Rangers).

Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July 1936: LNER Royal Northern Agricultural Society’s “Summer Show” Trains & Fares from Macduff, Alford & Inveramsay. \*

Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> September 1936: Half-day Excursion Inverurie – Milltimber (Boy Scouts' Rally at Milltimber) \*

From 1<sup>st</sup> October 1937: Cheap Fares from Drum on Deeside Line. \*

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> October 1950: Excursions from GNSR stations to Aberdeen (Aberdeen v Celtic). \*

Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> December & Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> December 1950: Excursions from GNSR stations to Aberdeen (Aberdeen v Hearts & Aberdeen v Motherwell). \*

February 1951: Springtime Cheap Tickets from Banchory, Crathes, Culter, Cults, Drum & Park along Deeside Line. \*

February 1955: Three-Day Excursion Tickets from Aberdeen & Kittybrewster to GNSR stations & Nairn.

13<sup>th</sup> June – 17<sup>th</sup> September 1955: Excursions from Coast Line stations to Aberdeen. \*

29<sup>th</sup> April – 27<sup>th</sup> October 1956: Runabout Tickets in other areas of Scotland. \*

May 1956: Special Cheap Day Tickets from Buchan Line stations to Aberdeen. \*

May 1956: Special Cheap Day Tickets from Peterhead – Mintlaw stations to Aberdeen & Buchan Line stations. \*

Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> September 1956: Excursions from Deeside Line stations to Aboyne (Aboyne Highland Games). \*

Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 1957: BR “Evening Excursion To Aberdeen” Elgin to Aberdeen via Glen Line (“Puss In Boots” at H.M. Theatre). \*

15<sup>th</sup> June – 13<sup>th</sup> September 1959: Introduction of Diesel Train Services between Aberdeen, Peterhead, Fraserburgh & St. Combs.

14<sup>th</sup> December 1959 – 2<sup>nd</sup> January 1960: Special Day Excursions from Aberdeen.

Early 1960s: Special Cheap Day Tickets from Auchindachy, Grange, Keith (Junction & Town) & Towiemore Halt to Elgin & various GNSR stations.

11<sup>th</sup> June – 10<sup>th</sup> September 1960: Battery Railcar and Diesel Services Deeside Line.

1<sup>st</sup> July – 10<sup>th</sup> September 1960: New Fast Diesel Trains Aberdeen – Inverness.

6<sup>th</sup> February – 11<sup>th</sup> June 1961: Train Services and Cheap Fares from Dee Street Halt (Banchory).

April 1961: Week-end Tickets from Huntly, Inch & Inverurie to Edinburgh, Glasgow, Inverness, etc.

Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April 1961: Day Circular Tour from Aberdeen via Speyside Line (outwards) and via Forfar, Bridge of Dun & Stonehave (return).

17<sup>th</sup> June – 9<sup>th</sup> September 1961: Evening Excursions from Main Line stations to Aberdeen. \*

December 1961: New Year Holiday Trains (1962) and Cancelled Passenger Train Services.

March 1962: Special Cheap Day Tickets from Dyce to various GNSR stations. \*

March 1962: Special Cheap Day Tickets from Aberdeen & Kittybrewster to various GNSR stations.

Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1962: Aberdeen Spring Holiday Fares from Aberdeen & Kittybrewster to Tayside, Strathmore and Coast stations.

18<sup>th</sup> June 1962 u. f. n.: Inverness to Aberdeen by Fast Diesel Trains.

September 1962: Special Cheap Day Tickets from Aberdeen & Kittybrewster to various GNSR stations. \*

September 1962: Special Cheap Day Tickets from Banff, Cornhill, Glenbarry, Ladysbridge & Tillynaught to Aberdeen & Coast Line stations.

May – September 1963: Camping Apartments in Scotland Season 1963.

17<sup>th</sup> June – 7<sup>th</sup> September 1963: Diesel Train Services Deeside Line.

1968: BR Inter-City “Now farmers and families go direct...” to Aberdeen (Main Line) (Copy).

1968: BR Inter-City “Now coopers and customers go direct...” to Aberdeen (Main Line) (Copy).

Until April 1970: BR Inter-City “Catch The Shoppers’ Train To Aberdeen” every Thursday from Inverness (Copy).

18<sup>th</sup> October 1970 till 2<sup>nd</sup> May 1971: “Rail Information Sheet” East Coast. \*

Until 30<sup>th</sup> April 1972: Inter-City Sleepers “Principal Sleeper Services from and to Scottish Stations”. \*

1970s: BR Inter-City “Escape route for Inverness housewives” to Aberdeen (Copy).

1973: BR “Mystery Tours” from Dundee, Aberdeen, Edinburgh. \*

2<sup>nd</sup> October 1978 – 12<sup>th</sup> May 1979: “Train Services between Aberdeen and Inverness”. \*
